You may remember in November our church decided to help the Buchanan Church located in Liberia, West Africa. The building was destroyed over a year ago in a wind-storm and replaced with a makeshift replacement. Churches of the United Brethren in Christ were challenged to raise \$14,600.00 to build this congregation a new sanctuary at the UB Connect event held at RGC in November of 2018.

Reconstruction of this church is underway! The congregation continues to meet in the old building while the walls for the new building are going up around it. The last check from pledges made in November was received at UB Global last week. Total raised for this project from the churches located in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, and West Virginia exceeded \$14,600! Total given during the UB Connect event exceeded \$32,000.00.
