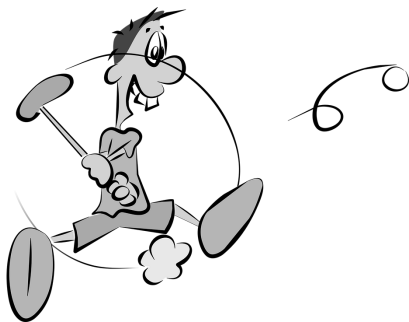
**Golf Tournament**
