Mission Focus

Josh was diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia in 2010. The cancer was held in remission till he was switched to another kind of cheaper chemotherapy when his insurance could no longer cover the \$12-14 thousand monthly cost. Josh is no longer in remission, in fact there has been an increase in cancer cells in his body for the first time in nine years.

Tests are being performed to see if his body has become resistant or developed a mutation to the chemo. If this has not occurred, the doctors will place him back on his old chemo treatments. No coverage by his insurance though to cover his expenses if he is returned to his previous chemo that worked for nine years.
