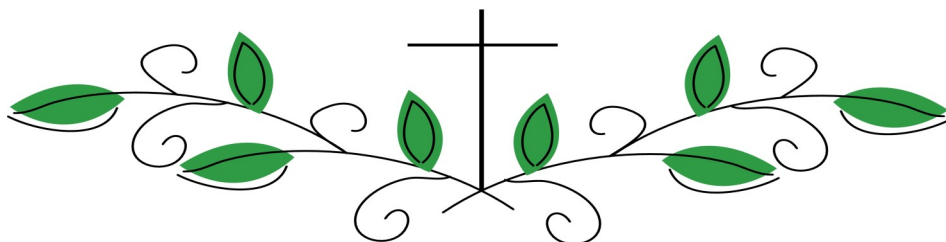

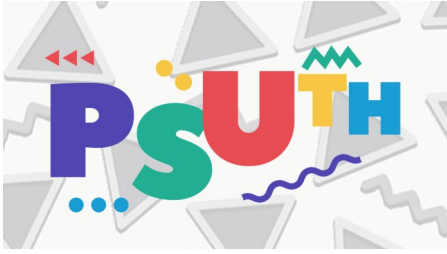

Hello,

I apologize for not responding sooner. I want to thank everyone in Angel Tree for the giving of gifts to incarcerated person's children. We, the men I'm with here, look forward to this every year. While the holidays are very stressful being forcibly kept from family and loved ones, this provides a ray of sunshine that brings even us supposed hardened criminals to tears of joy knowing our kids are having something from us. Many men here do not have jobs, there is about 2,200 here and about 1/2 as many jobs. This makes what you do so much more unredeemable to us. I call my children and hear the joy in their voices that a present was under the tree was noted as being from me. THANK YOU!

After serving in the Marines, I had various other jobs but mostly drove semis. When I got a job that allowed me to take off Thanksgiving or Christmas, I would go to the truck stop and find a driver or husband and wife team like I and my wife did, and bring them home to share the holiday. I can only imagine you all feel as I did then and wanted to write and express my thanks.

I wish to express my thanks to the Mission's Commission for giving me a gift card to celebrate me becoming a Practical Nurse. It took a while, but I now am working at a nursing home doing what I love to do to help and care for others. Your love in giving me encouragement and support was and is greatly appreciated. My children also appreciated the gifts they received through the Angel Tree Ministry.

Our family would like to express our heartfelt thanks for your generosity of gifts you provided to a child on behalf of his father. He was really surprised. Thank you so much! You made his day extra special!
