June Brown, a UB Missionary for 35 years in Sierra Leone passed away on June 4, 2020. June grew up in the King Street UB Church in Chambersburg, PA. June sensed a calling to the mission field early in her life. In 1957, she traveled to Sierra Leone and became a teacher. She taught 6 years in the Centennial School in Mattru and 29 years at the Bump High School. Her career as a teacher ended in 1992 when civil war broke out in the country, and missionaries were required to return to the states. Private graveside service will be held at Norland Cemetery.
