### Offering Envelopes

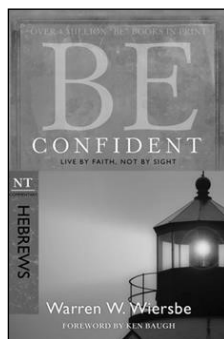

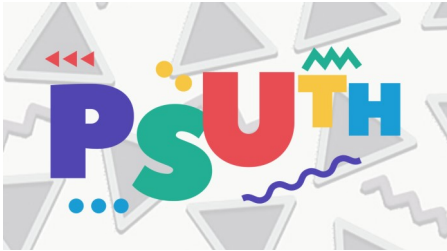

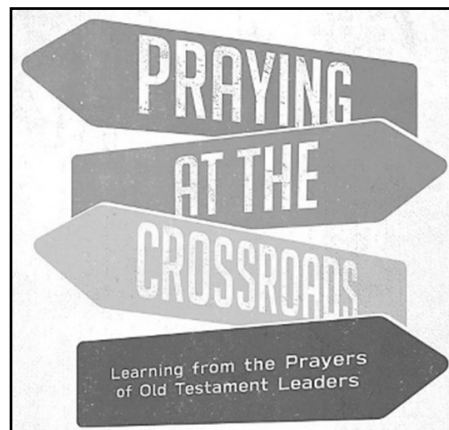
## **Sermon Information**
