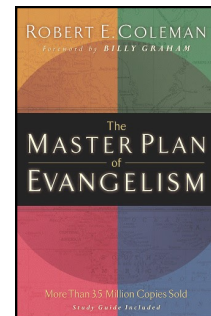
Mission Trip Opportunity!
