Large Print Our Daily Bread

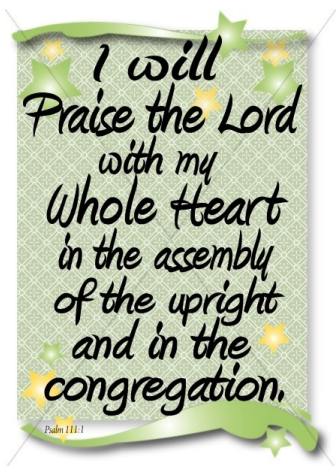
The July-September issues of Our Daily Bread, large print version, are now on the information table in the back of the sanctuary. Feel free to pick one up.
