Graduating?

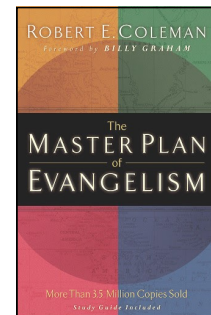
