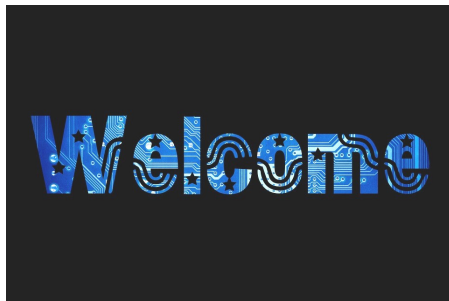
### Office Hours
