Calling All Young Adults!

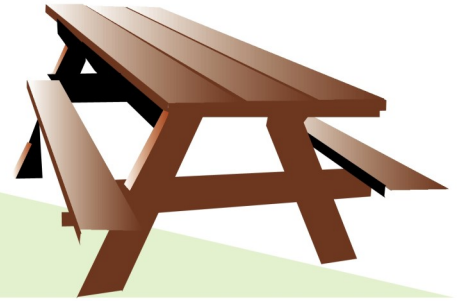
