



## Porter Samaritan Fund

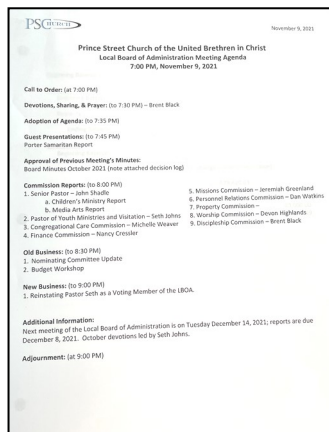

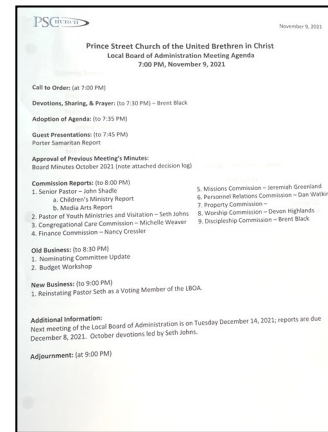
