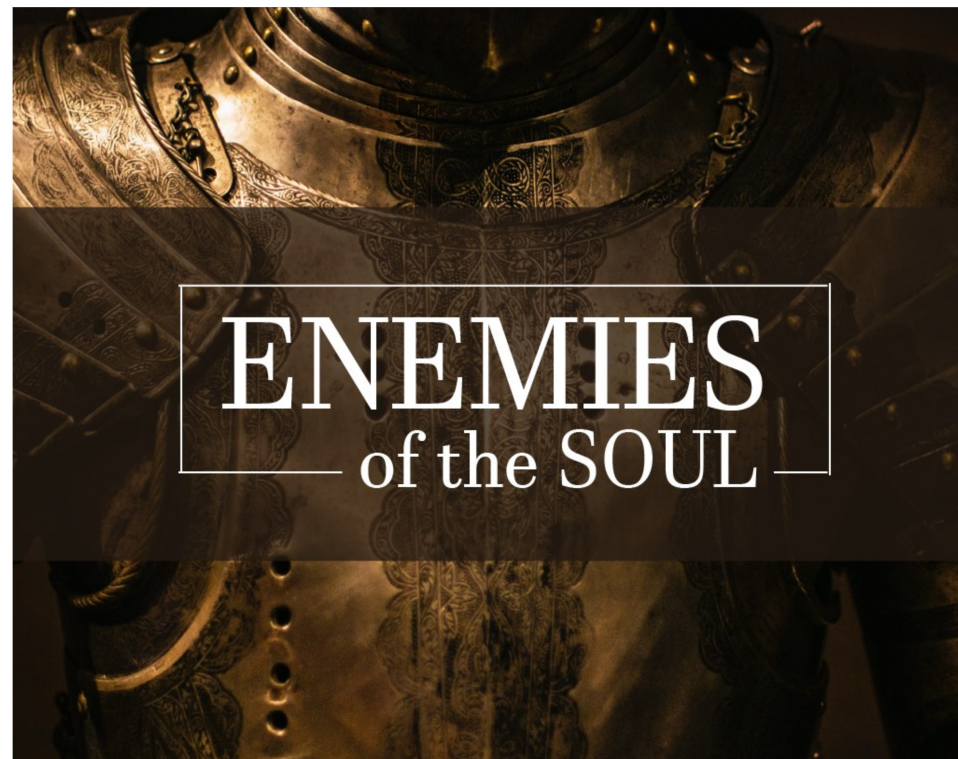

Sermon Information

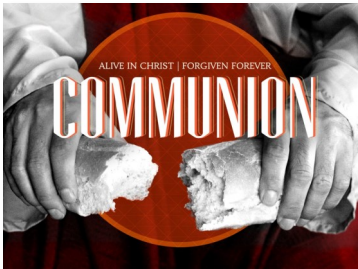

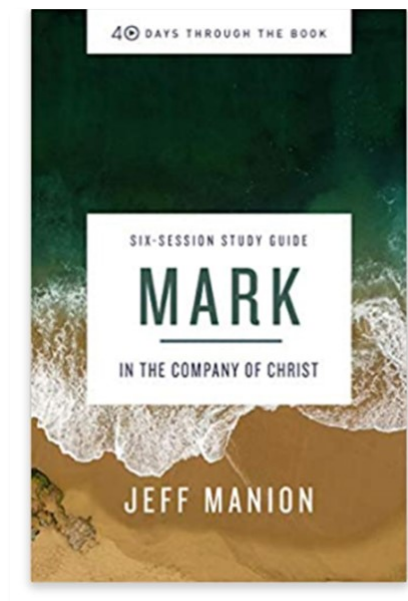
Youth Mission Trip
