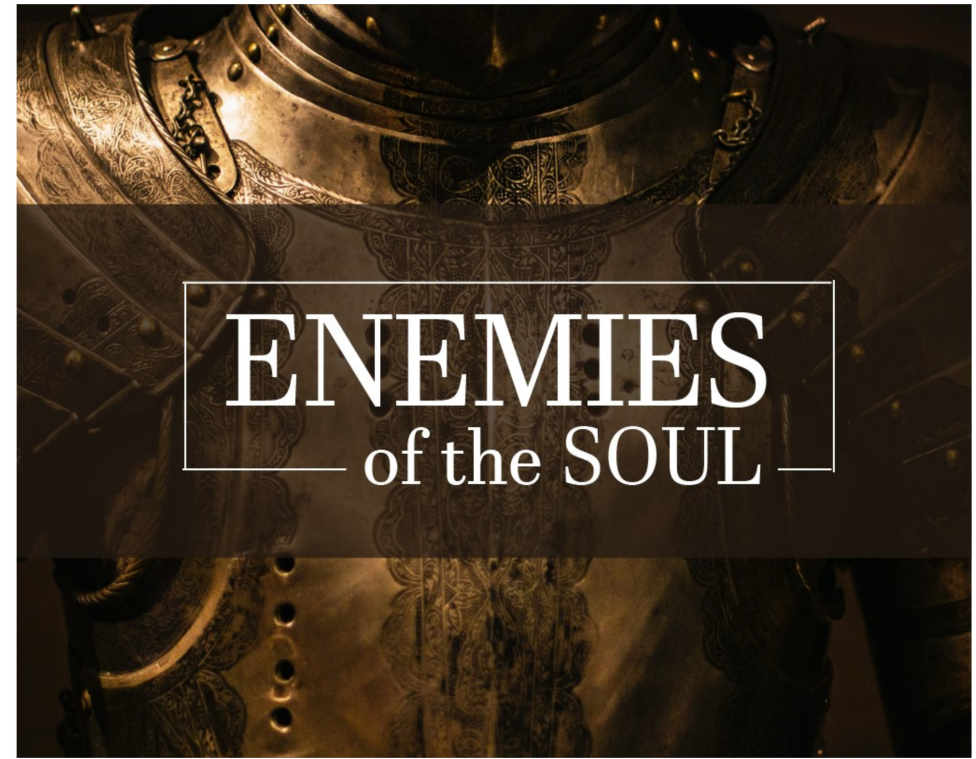

Sermon Information

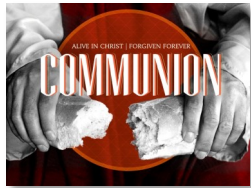

Today, May 8, we will be observing the Ordinance of Holy Communion during both morning worship services.



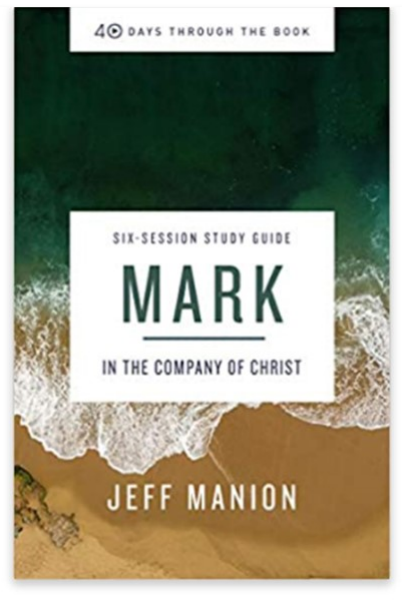
Baptism

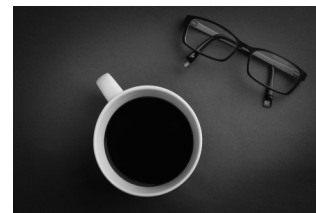
Happy Birthday!

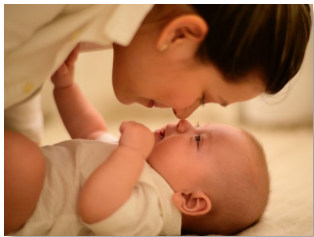
VBS!
