Our Daily Bread - Large Print

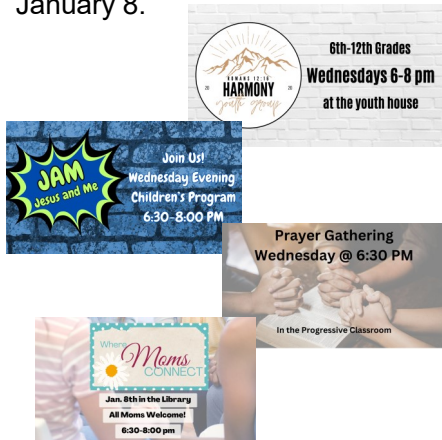
The large print version of Our Daily Bread, Jan.-Mar. issue, is now available for anyone who may be interested, and can be found in the back of the sanctuary.
